

ORDINANCE NO. 4-75

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WINTER MOORAGE RATES AND AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1975.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT:

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. Findings and determinations. The Port of Newport, by Ordinance No. 2, 1975 established and provided for moorage rates for Annual, Annual-Transient and transient vessels.

The Port has determined that there are a number of transient vessels which are moored at Port facilities for the non-trolling season from October 15 to April 14 which use Newport as a home Port; and, that it would be beneficial to the Port and the people there of that said vessels be afforded a winter moorage rate less than that of straight transient daily or monthly rate.

Section 2. Definition. The terms defined in this Section shall, for the purposes of this Ordinance and all ordinances and resolutions supplemented hereto now or hereafter adopted, have the meanings herein specified, unless the context clearly otherwise requires. The definitions of Ordinance No. 2, 1975 are adopted and made part hereof by this reference.

"Winter storage": means moorage assigned for the period from October 15 through April 14 which shall be paid in advance for the entire term, on or before October 15, and which does not necessarily include a stall assignment and which does not confer any rights or

benefits of an annual-transient moorage.

ARTICLE II


Section 1. Moorage fees for winter storage:

The moorage fees for winter storage (October 15 through April 14) shall be Seventy-five percent (75%) of the annual moorage fees for the same size and classification of vessel.



NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

PORT OF NEWPORT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Port of Newport adopted an emergency ordinance at its regular meeting on Wednesday, August 16, 1978, said ordinance effective immediately. A copy is on file at the Port Office and at the office of the Lincoln County Clerk for public inspection.

The ordinance imposes the requirement that moorage users must contact the Port within two (2) hours to provide for proper space assignment, payment of moorage fees and related matters.
