

PORT OF NEWPORT
ORDINANCE NO. 4, 1968

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING WELDING ON PORT OF NEWPORT DOCKS IN YAQUINA BAY TO DOCK NO. 6 ONLY: PRESCRIBING WELDING PROCEDURE: PRESCRIBING LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM WELDING THEREON: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF NEWPORT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for anyone to use any welding equipment on any dock of the Port of Newport in Yaquina Bay except Dock No. 6, and

Section 2. No welding shall be done on the said Port of Newport Dock No. 6 unless done by a person experienced in the art of welding using equipment having the minimum safety requirements and having in his possession a fire extinguisher of the kind approved by the U.S. Coast Guard for use on commercial fishing vessels, and

Section 3. Anyone using, or causing to be used, welding equipment on the said Port of Newport Dock No. 6, shall be liable for all loss resulting from said activity, and

Section 4. In addition to the civil liability herein prescribed, anyone violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to a maximum of ninety days in jail or fined not exceeding three hundred dollars or by both such fine and imprisonment, and

Section 5. WHEREAS an emergency is hereby deemed to exist, and it is declared necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Lincoln County, Oregon, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

This Ordinance is declared adopted this 9th day of December, 1968.
